France: AgreenSkills+ Post Doctoral Fellowships. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 13 October, 2017

Italy: Fernand Braudel Senior Fellowships. Deadline 30 September



Fernand Braudel Senior Fellowships provide a framework for established academics with an international reputation to pursue their research at the European University Institute (EUI). The European University Institute is seated on the Tuscan hillside overlooking Florence and close to Fiesole. Fellowships last for up to ten months in one of the EUI's four Departments (Law, History, Economics, and Political Science) which in turn invite fellows to participate in departmental activities (seminars, workshops, colloquia, etc.). European Respiratory Society Short Term Fellowships. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 1 October, 2017



Short-Term Research Fellowships are established to enable young scientists and clinicians in the early-stages of their research career in respiratory medicine to visit a Host Unit in a (European) country other than the candidate's own, with the aim of learning a research technique not available in the Home Unit. The research training should benefit the Home Unit when the applicant returns there, by leading to research developments and activities back onsite. More [here](#).

United Kingdom: Master's Fellowships in Public Health and Tropical Medicine for Researchers from Low and Middle Income Countries. ASEAN Researchers Encouraged to Apply. Deadline 31 August



This scheme provides junior researchers from low and middle income countries with the opportunity to gain research experience and training at Master's degree level. The scheme aims to support research that will improve public health and tropical medicine at a local, national and global level. Details [here](#).

Germany: Humboldt Foundation Georg Forster Award. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Rolling Deadline



The Georg Forster Research Award is granted in recognition of a researcher's entire achievements to date to academics of all disciplines whose fundamental discoveries, new theories, or insights have had a significant impact on their own discipline and beyond and who are expected to continue developing research-based solutions to the specific challenges facing transition and developing countries. Nominees must be nationals of a developing or transition country. The award amount totals €60,000. Details [here](#)

United Kingdom/Malaysia: Newton Fund Competition. UK-Malaysia Urban Innovation Challenge 2017. Deadline 30 August, 2017



Innovate UK is investing up to £3 million for projects that use cutting-edge solutions to improve cities in Malaysia. The aim of this competition is to encourage innovative partnerships between the UK and Malaysia. Projects should address one or more of the following urban challenges: urban mobility, urban waste; urban water management. Businesses can get up to 70% of their eligible project costs,

United Kingdom: Newton Fund Vietnam – UK Research Environment Links (REL) Grants. Deadline 21 July, 2017



REL grants aim to support international collaboration through training programmes, the exchange of knowledge and best practice, the development and implementation of pilot activities in the areas relevant to the Newton capacity building strands. The partnerships are led by institutions in Vietnam in conjunction with an expert

France: Call for Proposals. Franco-Thai Cooperation Programme in Higher Education and Research. Deadline 20 July, 2017



This programme aims at developing scientific exchanges between research laboratories in France and Thailand. The objective is to develop joint projects in research and/or research training in the following areas: basic science, energy, engineering, environment and biodiversity, agriculture, and social sickness. Are you a physicist/engineer with applied knowledge of superconductivity, low-temperature physics, refrigeration technologies or related fields? Are you a material scientist? Are you an economist interested in innovation management? Would you like to do your PhD in a stimulating international training network? EASITrain is a 4-year Marie Skłodowska-Curie ITN project providing a training network for the career development of 15 Early Stage Researchers (ESRs) on superconducting wires, superconducting thin films, related manufacturing and processing techniques and innovative cryogenic refrigeration.

Each ESR is funded by the project for 36 months and will be enrolled in a doctorate program. More info [here](#)

The research opportunity will look at the role of tropical waves on the weather of Southeast Asia, evaluating multiple large scale wave phenomena in both observations as well as global and regional scale models. This activity is intended to look at the influence that tropical waves have on weather patterns in the region,

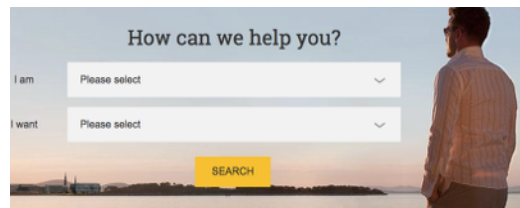
investigating if this is represented correctly in models and putting forward tested hypotheses on how to improve prediction. Details [here](#)

Deadline 15 September, 2017



The Austrian Academy of Sciences (OeAW) is offering Doctoral fellowships to enable young, excellent doctoral candidates from **all disciplines and nationalities** to carry out their PhD project within a definable period of time in Austria. Applicants must have obtained their master's degree less than 2 years prior to the deadline. Upon successful application, they must enrol in a doctoral programme in Austria. The fellowship provides a gross annual sum of EUR 38 000 for a duration of 24 to 36 months. Details [here](#).
