Learn About the Funding Opportunities Available to ASEAN Researchers Through Horizon 2020.



The final edition of the EURAXESS ASEAN quarterly Newsletter 2017 is out now. We provide an overview of the opportunities available to ASEAN based researchers from Horizon 2020 which is the EU's largest research and innovation programme ever. Horizon 2020 includes the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) which provide grants for all stages of researchers' careers - be they doctoral candidates or highly experienced researchers - and encourage transnational, intersectoral and

Europe: MSCA Research and Innovation Staff Exchange (RISE) Call. ASEAN Universities and Research Institutes Eligible. Deadline 21 March 2018



Research and Innovation Staff Exchange (RISE) funds short-term exchanges for staff to develop careers combining scientific excellence with exposure to other countries and sectors. RISE enables more interaction between academia and non-academic organisations within Europe and worldwide. Europe: Erasmus+ Scholarships. Opportunities for ASEAN Students, Researchers and institutions to Study, Teach or Conduct Research in Europe



Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training, youth, and sport for the period 2014 - 2020. It offers a range of opportunities for higher education students, doctoral candidates, staff and institutions from around the world including ASEAN. Denmark: Call for Research Collaboration Projects in Growth and Transition Countries. Indonesia, Myanmar and Vietnam Eligible. Deadline 2 February 2018



Supports strategic research cooperation projects between a research institution or a university in Denmark and a partner country including **Indonesia, Myanmar, and Vietnam.** Research-based institutions in Denmark are eligible for these research grants and only in partnership with research institutions in the countries mentioned above. The duration of projects is 18 to 36 months within a maximum grant of DKK 5 million for each project. More info [here](#)

France: EIFFEL Excellence Scholarships 2018 - ASEAN Students Encouraged to Apply. Deadline 12 January, 2018



Masters (12 to 36 months) and PhD courses (for 10 months under a thesis joint supervision or co-tutorship). Areas of study: engineering, economics and management, law and political science. Applicants must be no more than 30 years old for masters, 35 years old for PhD. Note that applications must be submitted by the French higher education institutions. Details [here](#)

France: Franco-Thai Scholarship Programme for Master or PhD Studies in France. Open until 19 February 2018.



The Franco–Thai Scholarship Program aims to support Thai students under the age of 35 who intend to study in French universities or Higher Education Institutions, at Master's degree or PhD level. This call for applications is open to all fields of studies. The application process is on-line and Campus France will be running preparatory workshops. More info [here](#)

Germany: International Climate Protection Fellowship for Young Climate Experts from Developing Countries. Deadline 1 March 2018



With the International Climate Protection Fellowships, the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation enables prospective leaders in academia and industry to implement a research-based proposal in the field of climate protection or climate-related resource conservation during a one-year stay in Germany. The monthly fellowship amount – depending on career stage – is €2,150 or €2,450 for fellows without a doctorate and €2,650 for postdoctoral researchers. Details [here](#)

Ireland: 71 EDGE Fellowships in ICT and Materials. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 31 January 2018



EDGE Fellowships are for experienced researchers seeking a prestigious career development 24 month fellowship based in one of ten of Ireland's third-level institutes. Eligibility: experienced researchers of any nationality and residing worldwide. Ranging from Candidates with less than 4 years post-PhD (or equivalent) experience to more than 6 years post-PhD experience. Details [here](#)

Italy: 65 International PhD Positions at the Sant' Anna School of Advanced Studies. ASEAN Students Eligible.



The Ph.D. Programmes at the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna are designed for talented graduates from around the world, who wish to carry out study and research in an international campus based in Pisa, Italy. For the academic year 2018/2019, there are 65 positions for Ph.D. students covered with a corresponding number of scholarships in a number of fields including economics, human rights and global politics, agrobiosciences, and digital economy and emerging digital economy. United Kingdom: Wellcome Trust Doctoral Studentships. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 29 March 2018



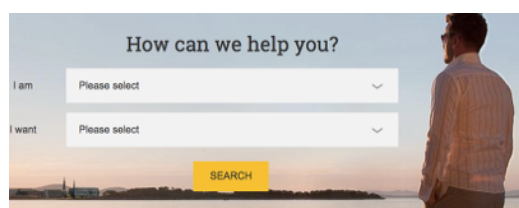
This scheme enables researchers to undertake humanities or social science doctoral degrees in any area of health. You can apply for a Doctoral Studentship if you want to complete a period of research leading to a PhD in any humanities or social science area. You must have been accepted onto a PhD programme with an eligible host organisation in the UK, Republic of Ireland or a low- or middle-income country. You can be of any nationality. United Kingdom: President's PhD Scholarships at Imperial College. ASEAN Students Eligible. Call Open Now.



If you are a high performing undergraduate or Master's student and have a strong desire to undertake a PhD programme at a world class research institution, you could be selected to receive full tuition fees and a generous stipend for a PhD place at Imperial College London. The President's PhD Scholarships aims to provide up to 50 research students with great potential the opportunity to work within their chosen research field with the support of an excellent supervisor.
