United Kingdom: Training Fellowships in Public Health and Tropical Medicine for Researchers from Low and Middle Income Countries. Preliminary deadline 30 November



This scheme offers research experience and training to early-stage researchers from low- and middle-income countries. The scheme aims to support research that will improve public health and tropical medicine at a local, national and global level. More info here.

United Kingdom: Newton Fund Institutional Links Programme. Thai Researchers Eligible. **Deadline 19 September**

Newton Newton Institutional Links aims to build UK-partner country research and innovation collaborations centred on shared research and innovation challenges, which have direct collaborations centred on shared research and innovation challenges, which have direct relevance to social welfare and economic development. Seed funding of £50,000 -£300,000 to initiate and support the joint development of research and innovation collaborations between the UK and partnering research groups or institutions. Details here.

United Kingdom: Newton Fund Researcher Links Travel Grants. Researchers from Indonesia and Philippines Eligible. Deadline 19 September



These grants provide financial support for early-career researchers to undertake an international research placement to strengthen links for future collaboration, build research capacity in developing economies, and enhance the researcher's career opportunities. Researchers that reside in the UK can apply for funding to visit a

university or research institution in one of the partner countries, and those residing in one of the partner countries can apply for funding to come to the UK. Details here.

United Kingdom: Newton Fund Researcher Links Workshop Grants. Researchers from the Philippines Eligible. Deadline 19 September



Newton Researcher Links Workshops bring together early-career researchers from the UK and the Philippines to make international connections that can improve the quality of their research. Grants are available for early-career researchers in the UK and the country hosting the workshop to attend. Each proposal must have one workshop

coordinator from the UK, as well as a workshop coordinator from the Philippines. Details here.

Italy/Europe. 24 MSCA Post Doc Positions in Nanomedicine, Neuroscience and Robotics. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 31 August



Istituto Italiano di Tecnologia (IIT) is seeking for 24 research fellows to be involved in Marie Sklodowska-Curie COFUND project "MINDED" in the fields of nanomedicine, neuroscience and robotics with the aim of developing new approaches for the diagnosis, imaging and treatment of neurodevelopmental disorders. Programme starts in early 2018 and will involve 16 more institutions

based in Italy, Europe, Israel and USA. Research fellows are funded by the European Commission (50%) and by the IIT (50%). Details here.

United Kingdom: Post-doctoral Fellowships at the Science and Technology Facilities Council Laboratories (STFC) in the UK. Deadline: 29 September



The Rutherford International Fellowship Programme (RIFP) is funded through the Marie Sklodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) and is designed to attract the highest-quality researchers who can take advantage of the world-class facilities and departments within STFC. These include the ISIS neutron and muon source, the Diamond Light Source (DLS) and the

Central Laser Facility (CLF); the Particle Physics, RAL Space, Scientific Computing, Accelerator and Technology Departments, as well as the UK Astronomy Technology Centre (UKATC). Details here.

Switzerland - 15 PhD Positions at EASITrain Innovative Training Network (ITN). ASEANResearchers Eligible. Deadline 02 October, 2017



Would you like to do your PhD in a stimulating international training network? EASITrain is a 4-year Marie Sklodowska-Curie ITN project providing a training network for the career Early development o f 15 Stage Researchers on superconducting wires, superconducting thin films, related manufacturing and processing techniques and innovative cryogenic refrigeration. Each ESR is funded by the project for 36

months and will be enrolled in a doctorate program. More info here.


ASEM-DUO Thailand Fellowship Programme. Open to University Graduates and Undergraduates. Deadline 31 August, 2017
